

Drive to the Rabbi's house. An attendant will give you a handout with the places you may park. YOU MAY NOT PARK ANYWHERE YOU WISH. Rabbi Marc did a lot of work to secure parking places acceptable to his development's Board and the City. We must respect the allotments and not park elsewhere.

Please respect the neighbors if they should ask you to move your car or not park in their swale - even if they had previously given permission to park there. By being respectful of their wishes, it will guarantee fewer problems in the future.

Through the Eyes of a Child

In Broward County, more than 2,500 children suffer pain of abuse,

abandonment, and neglect everyday. These cruelties do not just turn segments of skin purplish-blue or leave children lonely for the span of a day; they change innocent souls *for life*. To these children, abuse is not a distant crime read about in the newspaper, but a conflict that they cope with every day.

No matter your religion or faith, most agree that every child is born with a spirit capable of adding light to the world. Every child deserves the right to spread that brightness in an environment where they are safe and nurtured. By volunteering for the Broward County Guardian ad Litem Program (GALP), this can become possible.

Volunteer Guardians ad Litem serve as advocates for abused, abandoned and neglected children in the community and courtroom. Guardians give a voice to children at their most vulnerable time. We are all brought into the world for a purpose, and the GALP allows us to share that purpose by empowering our children to one day share theirs.

Guardians ad Litem must complete an application, interview, background check, and 30 hour training program to be certified.
