Delving into the handbook, "Counting the Omer with the Kabbalah," which Amichai published a couple of years ago, we will explore the ancient practice of connecting with each day of the Omer (the 50 days between Passover and Shavuot, called: the feast of the seven weeks.) The Omer parallels a lesser known Christian practice of honoring the 50 days between Easter and Pentecost, which means 50 days. The season of the Omer was based on early agricultural concerns of our Jewish ancestors. Later it was expanded and adapted to the devotional aspect of our religion, and applied to Kabbalistic practice. This practice develops much of the traditional imagery associated with the two holidays it connects: Pesach and Shavuot, which could be termed, respectively, the launching pad and landing pad for the journey into Omer time.


